

Travelling to South Farnborough Infant School

Introduction

At South Farnborough Infant school, we want to support our families travelling to school in a safe and where possible, active and sustainable manner. We actively encouraging walking, cycling, scooting and car sharing to and from school.



We have been awarded the Good level Modeshift STARS accreditation, a national accreditation programme dedicated to improving pupil health and well-being through active and sustainable travel.

As new parents to our school, we hope that you will choose sustainable travel options, in order to reduce the car traffic and pollution at the school gates and make it safer for our families who do walk, scoot or cycle.

Walking and scooting to school

It is easy to walk to school, and a lot of our families do. Queen's Road has footpaths both sides of the roads, and there is one zebra crossing just outside the school, and one slightly further down near to the entrance of Queen's Road car park.

We have ample scooter and cycle storage the at school, and it makes a healthy way to start the day.



Park and Stride



If you need to drive to school, please do not park outside the school gates – the road is very busy with residents parking. Never park on the zig zag markings, yellow lines, near junctions and driveways or reverse into spaces if you can't see clearly behind you – there might be a very young cyclist or pedestrian there.

We also do not allow parents to drive into the school.

There are two local car parks – Queen's Road car park and Peabody carpark. Queen's Road car park gets very busy at drop off and pick up, and to help alleviate this, we have set up a permit parking scheme with Rushmoor Borough Council at Peabody carpark. This enables you to park for free during drop off and pick up times, during term time. It is a 10 minute walk from the car park to the school, and we would encourage you to use this car park, if you can.
