Library

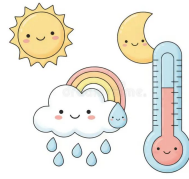
Children will visit

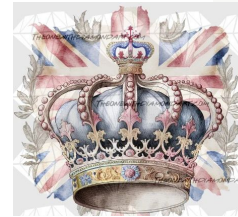
